



DAY CAMP PARENT INFO

Thank you for choosing Camp Sankanac for your child this summer! As we plan for camp, our desire and goal is to make it the best possible experience for your child in a safe, God honoring, outdoor environment. We trust and pray that each camper will return home stronger...stronger physically from the outdoor setting and challenging activities, stronger emotionally as they grow in confidence and build relationships with new friends and counselors, and stronger spiritually as they have the opportunity to learn more about God in a peaceful and focused setting, without distraction.

Here is some important information that will be helpful as you plan for your child's Sankanac experience...

Drop Off

- Campers are to be dropped off & picked up at the Traber Center (10 Traber Lane, Spring City, PA 19475). Please drive to back parking lot that is furthest from Pughtown Road.
- Drop off for Extended Stay campers is as early as 7:30am. For all other campers, drop off is 9am.
- If a child is on a medication that must be administered during Day Camp hours, please bring the meds in their original container. Medications must be submitted to the day camp director on Monday morning and will be administered as prescribed.

Pick Up

- Campers are to be picked up at the Traber Center at the same location they were dropped off at.
- Regular campers are to be picked up at 4pm. Extended Stay campers may be picked up as late as 5:30pm.

Please Leave At Home...

Cell Phones, All Electronics, Gum/Candy/Snacks

Camp Sankanac has a no cell phone policy. We will contact you in the event of an emergency. You will also be provided with the contact information of the camp director should you need to reach us. Campers will be provided with lunch & a snack each day. Extended stay campers are provided with breakfast, a snack & lunch.

What to Expect...

Our Day Campers have the unique opportunity to enjoy awesome camp activities in a structure that is comfortable for both first-timers and returning campers. Our schedule will be similar each day but activities will vary as the week progresses.

In the morning campers will enjoy Bible Study, game time, snack and a different "elective" activity (such as fishing, boating, archery, outdoor cooking, sports, crafts, pioneering/survival, etc). After lunch and some rest time, campers will enjoy the pool, Trading Post (our camp store) and another group activity before wrapping up the day to return home.

Campers will take a swim test the first day of camp. If they do not pass the deep water test, they will be restricted to the shallow end of the pool.

Day campers will not have much interaction with our overnight campers but will enjoy many of the same activities. Campers will work through a Bible book and will be challenged to grow spiritually as they learn new skills and enjoy life as a camper.
