### SCHEDULE:

9am- Drop Off @ Barn (see below for extended stay)

9:15am- Morning Activity Rotation

- Bible Study

- Riding Instruction/Activities

12pm- Change Clothes for Pool/Head to Lunch

12:30pm- Lunch

1:15pm- Pool

1:45pm- Change back into riding clothes

2pm- Trading Post (Wednesdays & Fridays only), Craft Time (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday)

2:30-4pm- Learning Activities: Grooming, tack, barn care/instruction, games, horse care & first aid

Adventure Activities: Riding bare back, creek stomping with the horses, trail rides, scavenger hunts

### PRICING

Standard Stay: \$350 Total

(\$100 Registration Deposit + \$250 Program Fee)

Extended Stay Option: \$375 Total

(\$100 Registration Deposit + \$275 Program Fee)

Standard stay price includes all aspects of programming and lunch each day. Extended Stay price includes breakfast & lunch and all aspects of programming.

### WHAT TO WEAR:

- Riding Boots or Boots with heel at least 1 inch that can catch a stirrup—NO SNEAKERS WHILE RIDING
- Tshirts are recommended for comfort and protection
- Stretch pants, Riding Pants or Jeans (NO SHORTS)
- Sunblock/Bug Spray

### BACKPACK PACKING LIST:

(a backpack is recommended as the kids will need to walk from the barn to the dining hall/pool each day)

- Bathing Suit/Towel/Flip Flops for Pool
- Sneakers or rain boots that can get wet (for creek activities)
- Water Bottle (Ice Water will be available for fill ups)
- Extra pair of stretch pants/jeans/riding pants & Tshirt
- Rain Gear (if forecast is calling for rain)
- Sunblock/Bug Spray
- Spending Money on Wednesday & Friday: Campers will have the opportunity to visit our camp store for snacks, ice cream and Sankanac gear.



### STANDARD STAY DROP OFF/PICK UP:

- Campers will be dropped off at 9am at the large red barn on the right hand side of the road as you are entering camp (if you see the pond on the right, you've just missed the barn). We will have signs to direct you. Location for drop off: 85 Bertolet School Road, Spring City PA 19475
- Campers need to be picked up at the same location at 4pm. Campers must be picked up by 4pm- please be on time for pick up. Thank you!

### EXTENDED STAY DROP OFF/PICK UP:

- Extended stay campers will be dropped off at the Traber Center and will eat breakfast with our regular day camp campers & staff. They will be picked up by horse camp staff and walk to the barn at 9am. Location for drop off: 10 Traber Lane, Spring City PA 19475.
- Campers will also be picked up at the Traber Center at 5:30pm. Please be on time to pick up your camper. Thanks!
