- DEADLINES

 Funds can be donated any time after the staff person has been accepted by the BCM Ministry, and up to the last day of August. Donation's received after that date will go to BCM's Camp Scholarship Fund.
- Any funds raised for your ministry will be paid to you in a lump sum during the last BCM pay period of September. As for all BCM missionaries, an administrative fee of 12% is applied to every
- AMOUNTS

 Total maximum pay amount is \$450/week (x number of weeks served at Ministry), including weekly salary offered by the Ministry. Example: Position pays \$150/week. Staff person works 4 weeks. Total fund raising allowed: \$450 \$150 = \$300 x 4 weeks = \$1,200 paid in September.
