# Overnight Boys' Camp and Girls' Camp I Ages 7-16

village so as to provide age-appropriate instruction. Camp Sankanac runs four weeks of Boys' Camp (June-July) and then four weeks of Girls' Camp (July-August). Each week goes from Sunday to Saturday.
