Overnight Boys' Camp and Girls' Camp | Ages 7-16

Get ready to have the best week of your life! Challenges from God's Word, crazy activities, great friendships with peers, and an awesome, Christ-centered group of staff make for a week you'll never forget! Overnight camps run from Sunday afternoon (check-in is 3-5pm) through Saturday morning (pick-up is 8:15-9:15am). We offer 4, one-week sessions for boys and 4, one-week sessions

for girls. Our overnight camps are divided into 3 different villages: Creekside (7-10yo), Pinesite (11-13yo) and Cliffside (14-16yo). While we do some things together as a whole camp (eating, some activities, some sessions), we have divided the campers in this way so we can provide age-appropriate instruction, Bible teaching, and interaction with other campers. Campers enjoy tons of fun group activities with their village and also have the opportunity to choose their own individual morning activities; selecting from a wide variety of fun and instructional "electives" that are taught by the counselors. 

Buddies campers join our Day Camp program but benefit from one-on-one supervision by staff that have been specially trained and prepared to serve and work with children with disabilities.*

Counselor in Training Program | Age 16

If you are 16 years of age (or have completed 10th grade) and are considering a future in leadership or summer camp counseling, we highly recommend this program! The CIT program is 3 weeks of handson leadership training and offers beneficial experiences and helpful preparation for a future leader. The first two weeks of training focus on spiritual growth and developing counseling skills as you prepare for the last week which consists of staying in a cabin and assisting counselors with younger campers and program related tasks. This program really gives you a taste of what summer camp counseling (and ministry in general) is all about. Whether you are looking at a future in summer camp ministry or any kind of leadership, this program is the perfect way to prepare and looks great on your future college application or resume!
