ELEGIBILITY

Every staff accepted to serve at a BCM ministry is automatically eligible.

GETTING AN ACCOUNT NUMBER

A BCM account number will be issued in your name for fundraising purposes. This number should be included on your support raising letter.

PREPARING YOUR SUPPORT LETTER

CONNECT WITH YOUR SUPPORTERS

Connect with family, friends and local churches regarding your summer ministry. You can do this by sending them your support raising letter, speaking to your church leaders, etc.

DEADLINES

Funds can be donated any time after the staff person has been accepted by the BCM Ministry, and up to the last day of August. Donations received after that date will go to BCM's Camp Scholarship Fund.

PAYMENTS

Any funds raised for your ministry will be paid to you in a lump sum during the last BCM pay period of September. As for all BCM missionaries, an administrative fee of 12% is applied to every donation.

8

AMOUNTS

Total maximum pay amount a participant can make is \$450 a week (salary + fundraising support).
- Any additional donation received will be directed to BCM's Camp Scholarship Fund to help children attend Camp.
