Get ready to have the best week of your life! Challenges from God's Word, crazy activities, great friendships with peers, and an awesome, Christcentered group of staff make for a week you'll never forget! Overnight camps run from Sunday afternoon (check-in is 3-5pm) through Saturday morning (pickup is 8:15-9:15am). We offer 4, one-week sessions for boys and 4, one-week sessions for girls. Our overnight camps are divided into 3 different villages: Creekside (7-10yo), Pinesite (11-13yo) and Cliffside (14-16yo). While we do some things together as a whole camp (eating, some activities, some meetings), we have divided the campers in this way so we can provide age-appropriate instruction, Bible teaching, and interaction with other campers. Campers enjoy tons of fun group activities with their village and have the opportunity to choose their own individual morning activities; selecting from a wide variety of fun and instructional "electives" that are taught by the counselors. Scholarships: Awarded scholarships will vary as we handle requests for scholarships on a case-by-case basis. Contact us using the info below.
