## To bring...

- \*Bible/Notebook/Pen

- \*Weather Appropriate Clothing: We can get anything from sunshine to rain...please pack according to weather conditions. We'll be enjoying the outdoors regardless, so play clothes are most appropriate. Extra clothes and shoes are recommended in case we get messy.
- \*Boots with a 1 inch heel for riding (sorry, no sneakers for riding)
- \*Sneakers or hiking boots are great for non-horse related activity
- \*Raincoat with a hood & rain boots if rain is forecasted
- \*Riding helmet (if you have one, if not, we can provide)
- \*Leggings or stretchy jeans for riding
- \*Backpack for carrying things to and from the barn
- \*Toiletries/Towels
- \*Flashlight

## Drop Off & Pick Up...

### DROP OFF:

- Please drop your camper off at 4pm on Friday at the Cliffside Village. Check in is at 4pm on Friday evening at the Cliffside Cabins. Please follow your GPS directions to 72 Bertolet School Road, Spring City, PA 19475 and just before you reach that destination, you will see the pond to your right (behind the hedgerow). After the pond/hedgerow, you'll see a driveway on the left just before a large stonefront building (our gymnasium). You'll make a left to go up that driveway (Timber Lane) and make your first RIGHT to arrive at Cliffside Village where your child's cabin is. Morgan, the Horse Camp Director, will be there to check you in and show you to your cabin.
- \*\*Please make every effort to drop your camper off on time. We'll be eating first thing and then heading up to the barn for activities. If you think you will be late, please reply to this email and let us know in advance to avoid confusion during programming that evening. Thank you!

\*\*If you anticipate being late for drop off, it's very important that you make us aware of that in advance so we can direct you according to where we will be at the time. Please email us at [info@campscanac.org](mailto:info@campscanac.org) if you are unable to get your camper to camp on time. Thanks!

### PICK UP:

- Please pick your camper up at Cliffside Village at 8pm on Saturday evening. Please be on time for pick up. Our staff thank you!

### **ATTIRE**

We will be outside most of the day, so play clothes and solid sneakers with socks are best for non-horse activities. If the weather is calling for rainy or cold weather, it's recommend that you pack according to the weather conditions. If rain is called for a rain coat with a hood and rain boots are recommended. A coat, hat and gloves are recommended for general use around camp, keeping in mind that conditions may include muddy/wet terrain and an environment that's standard for a barnyard. Please see packing list for riding attire.

### **BEHAVIOR**
